

Young People at Yontiv: Activities for Rosh Hashanah & Yom Kippur

*Your children (ages 3-11) can enjoy an array of activities suitable to their ages during both days of Rosh Hashanah and on Yom Kippur morning. These will include holiday crafts, singing with Daniela, our chazzan, making challah and being part of the shofar service with the rest of the congregation. We offer a special Yom Kippur service for the older children, with storytelling that morning for the little ones. And, of course, there are always healthy snacks, including on Yom Kippur morning.*

Specific activities and spaces for those ages 3-7 and ages 8-11 include:

Rosh Hashanah Day 1, Sept. 10, 10 a.m.-12:30 p.m.

All Ages: Singing with Daniela, our chazzan; crafts include making challah covers; participating in the shofar part of the service in sanctuary.

Rosh Hashanah Day 2, Sept. 11, 10 a.m.- 12:30 p.m.

All Ages: Challah making with Eden; making holiday cards, and other activities and games; participating in the shofar part of the service in sanctuary.

Yom Kippur Morning, Sept. 19, 10 a.m.-12:30 p.m.:

Ages 7-11: Torah Service led by Jamie Flagal, past president and frequent Torah chanter;

Ages 3-7: The Story of Jonah, told by Eden Nameri, resident storyteller and past president.

All Ages: Shofar craft and other holiday activities and games.

Childcare, with crafts and activities will be available for both age groups, on erev Rosh Hashanah (Sept. 9, 7-9 p.m.), Kol Nidre evening (6:45-9 p.m.) and all Yom Kippur afternoon and during Neilah (1:30 – 8 p.m.).

We welcome children in the sanctuary with their adults during the services, as well!
