

Shabbat Services/Kiddish Helpers Tasks

Attend on Saturday mornings in advance of the service to meet and greet congregants both in the lobby of the MNJCC and in the third-floor hallway, directing them to the chapel, the children's room, etc. and helping any disabled or elderly to their seats;

-Being in the entrance way after start of service to make sure all are welcomed and that there is space inside the chapel for them;

-As service ends, helping the elderly and disabled navigate through the hallway into the kiddish room, where they may need assistance getting food, beverages, finding seats;

-Talking to people who are alone or in any other kind of need to make them feel more welcome, comfortable and part of the community;

-As kiddish time ends, helping our staff person to clear tables of dishes, food, beverage cups, etc.;

-Helping in kitchen with food disposal, washing dishes, general clean-up, AFTER the kiddish ends.

-Other help on Saturday mornings (and the occasional other times) as needed and requested by Shabbat coordinator and/or staff.

(Please note that we cannot accommodate nor do we need helpers preparing food and setting up the kiddish, which our staff handles before the service. Please cooperate with us by staying out of the kitchen at this time.)
