Limited Income Criteria

Shir Libeynu's fees strive to balance affordability with adequate funding for our congregation throughout the year. We won't turn anyone away for lack of funds.

If you meet **any** of the criteria below, you can automatically purchase a limited income membership or single tickets:

- An individual earning \$35,000 or less, or a family earning \$50,000 or less, in gross annual income; or
- Senior citizens living exclusively on a fixed government income (e.g. OAS, GIS, CPP); or
- People living exclusively on a fixed income (e.g. social assistance, disability insurance, employment insurance); or
- A full-time student over 30 years of age (students 30 years of age or younger are entitled to our \$75 membership).

If you don't meet these criteria but want us to consider you for limited income membership or single tickets, please let us know by emailing shirlibeynu@yahoo.ca, or leaving a message at 416-465-5488, as early as possible. **We cannot provide special pricing on the days of the High Holiday services. All information you provide is confidential.**
